## **Important Instructions for Candidates**

- 1. All candidates must report at the test venue one hour before the scheduled start of their batch.
- 2. Candidates must bring the following documents for verification:
  - i) Admit Card issued for the CBT,
  - ii) One valid Photo ID Proof (Aadhaar Card / PAN Card / Voter ID / Driving License / Passport),
  - iii) Two recent passport-size photographs.
- 3. Candidates are advised to bring a blue or black ballpoint pen for use during the test.
- 4. The candidates willing to use their own key boards shall be allowed if they bring USB based key boards.
- 5. Candidates must not carry mobile phones, wrist watches, gold ornaments, or other valuables inside the test centre. The University or the test centre will not be responsible for the safety of such items.
- 6. Biometric-based attendance will be taken at the test centre to verify candidates' identity. Any candidate found indulging in proxy attendance, impersonation, or unfair means will be debarred from the recruitment process and disciplinary/legal action will be initiated against such candidates.
- 7. Candidates must maintain discipline and decorum and follow the invigilators' instructions throughout the test.
- 8. No request for change in date, time, or venue will be entertained under any circumstances.
- 9. No TA/DA will be paid for appearing in the Typing/Skill Test.
- 10. Failure to appear for the test on the specified date and time shall be treated as disinterest in the post, and the candidature will stand cancelled without further notice.
- 11. The Skill Test/Typing Test is qualifying in nature. Candidates must qualify with a minimum typing speed of 30 words per minute in English or 25 words per minute in
