Sardar Patel University Mandi is nestled in the lap of Himalayan ranges in the heartland district of Himachal Pradesh Mandi, is situated on the banks of mighty beas river is a residential cum affiliating University. It came into existence on 1 st April 2022 as a state University. vide H.P State Govt. Notification NO EDN-A- Ka(1)-17/2021 dated 28 February 2022. Sardar Patel University was formed into a full affiliating University by Mandi. Sardar Patel University Mandi has got the 2 (f) status of U.G.C and has jurisdiction over 5 districts of Himachal Pradesh comprising Mandi, Kullu, Lahul & Spiti, Chamba and Kangra. There are about 145 colleges and institutes of these 5 district affiliated to it. In University campus the undergraduate, post graduate and research programs are being offered. Besides the regular courses the University plans to introduce some regionally relevant courses that are of greatest significance for the mountainous region. Sardar Patel University is presently running 7 Ph. D. programs, 11 P.G. courses and one integrated course in the University campus.

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

1. Admission to all Post Graduate Courses (MA in History and Public Administration; MBA; MCA; M.Sc. in Botany, Chemistry, Environmental Science, Physics and Zoology) both in subsidized and non-subsidized seats, will be done through the Common Entrance Tests conducted by HP University, Shimla.
2. Admission in M.Sc. (Industrial chemistry) will be done on the basis of the entrance test conducted by Sardar Patel University marks obtained by the candidate in the qualifying examination.
3. Admission in M.Sc. (Geoinformatics) will be done on the basis of the merit.
4. Admission in Integrated B.Sc.-M.Sc. (Physics) will be done on the basis of the merit.
5. Those students who are interested in seeking admission must have appeared in Common Entrance Test conducted by HP University and are directed to apply for counseling in the above said courses by visiting Sardar Patel University Website (www.spumandi.ac.in). Candidates are also advised to follow the admission related updates regularly on the website.
6. Separate merit lists will be prepared for subsidized and non-subsidized seats.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

Age Limit

The maximum age limit is 26 years for boys and 28 years for girls (29 years in case of SC/ST candidates both for Boys & Girls) as on 1st July of the concerned year. Provided, that the Vice Chancellor shall have the power to permit age relaxation for reason to be recorded in writing to a maximum of six months. Provided further that age bar shall not apply in case of Defense Personnel.

Eligibility Criteria to M.Sc. (Botany/ Geoinformatics/ Zoology/ Physics / Chemistry/ Industrial Chemistry and Environmental Science)

1. The minimum eligibility for admission to Postgraduate courses will be 20-24 credits in the subject concerned in the Undergraduate degree.
2. A Bachelor's degree with 2nd Division or with at least 45% marks (40% in case of SC/ST candidates) in aggregate in the subject concerned in three years of degree or Honors in the subject concerned.

The Eligibility Criteria for MCA

1. Bachelor of Computer Applications (BCA) / B. Sc. (Computer Science) / B. Sc. (IT) / BA (Computer Science)/ BA (IT) OR any Graduate in concerned subject.
2. A Bachelor's degree with 2nd Division or with at least 45% marks (40% in case of SC/ST candidates) in aggregate in the subject concerned in three years of degree or Honors in the subject concerned.

The Eligibility Criteria for MBA, MA (History and Public Administration)

Candidate should hold a Bachelor's degree or equivalent qualification from a recognized university/institution with at least 45% marks (40% marks in the case of Scheduled Caste/ Scheduled Tribe).

The Eligibility Criteria for B.Sc.-M.Sc. Integrated (Physics)

Candidate must have 60% marks or equivalent grade in aggregate in 10+2 from any recognized board with Physics and Mathematics as subjects and at least 60 percent marks in Physics.

RESERVATION OF SEATS

Reservation in admission to all programmes (except Non- subsidized seats) shall be as per the 120 point Reservation Roster as followed by HP University, Shimla.
